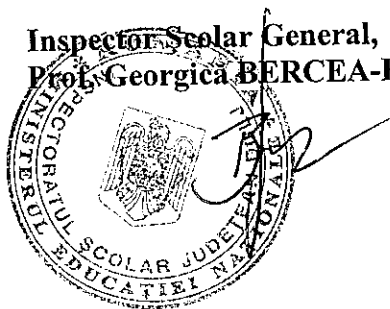

Conditions of Competition-Festival

1. Young and junior pianists, born after 11 June 1995, from different countries can become participants of the competition-festival.
2. The competition-festival will be of 3 age groups:
 - JUNIOR "A" GROUP includes participants up to 10 years of age
 - JUNIOR "B" GROUP includes participants 11-14 years of age
 - YOUNG GROUP includes participants 15-17 years of age
3. The junior "A" and "B" age groups of competition-festival will be held in one round.
4. The young group of competition-festival will be held in 2 rounds, and all contestants must play two rounds programs.
5. The playing order of contestants is to be determined by ballot and it is unchangeable during the rounds.
6. All the compositions are to be played by memory /no sheet music/.
7. The money prizes are parted between the participant and teacher.
8. Participants are provided with one acoustical rehearsal and foreign participants are also provided with rehearsal rooms.
9. Foreign participants have to get an entrance visa to Armenia, applying to the embassy of the Republic of Armenia in their country after receiving the invitation.
10. Participants must pay for their accommodation and road expenses.

11. The contest-festival will be held in Yerevan state musical-pedagogical college after Arno Babajanyan and Aram Khachaturian House-Museum.
12. Audio and video recording rights reserves organization committee of competition-festival.
13. Participants who were laureates of previous competition-festival cannot become participants of the same age group.
14. The participation fee is 10.000 AMD which should be paid on-spot on festival opening day (12 June 2013) and is not subjected to reimbursement.

1st reward-300 USD, laureate diploma

2nd reward- 200 USD, laureate diploma

3rd reward- 100 USD, laureate diploma

Encouraging prizes – 50 USD and the diploma

JUNIOR "B" GROUP

1st award-400 USD, laureate diploma

2nd award- 300 USD, laureate diploma

3rd award- 200 USD, laureate diploma

Encouraging prizes - 50 USD and the diploma

YOUNG GROUP

1st award-700 USD, laureate diploma

2nd award- 500 USD, laureate diploma

3rd award- 300 USD, laureate diploma

Encouraging prizes - 100 USD and the diploma

Financial prizes are to be paid in AMD.

Also special awards are defined.

The jury has the right not to award or divide awards.

The jury has the right to stop the play if the participant exceeds the mentioned time.

Jury's decision is final and is not subjected.

The program of the competition-festival

JUNIOR A GROUP

/participants up to 10 years of age/

The participants of this age-group can have a free program /total duration 10-15 minutes/, which should include any composition of Arno Babajanyan.

JUNIOR B GROUP

/participants 11-14 years of age/

15-20 minutes program

1. The first movement from a sonata or sonatina (Hayden, Mozart, Beethoven, Clementi)
2. Any composition of Arno Babajanyan
3. 1 or 2 compositions on participant's choice

YOUNG GROUP

/participants 15-17 years of age/

1st round

15-20 minutes program

1. One virtuoso etude / Chopin, Liszt, Rachmaninov, Skriabin, Debussy/
2. The first movement from classical sonata (Hayden, Mozart, Beethoven)
3. Any composition of an Armenian composer or the nationality of the participant / foreign participants should introduce notes to jury/

2nd round

20-25 minutes program

1. Arno Babajanyan- one of obligatory performance:
 - "Prelude" and "Dance of Vagharshapat"
 - "Impromptus" and "Dance of Vagharshapat"
 - Three pictures from "Six pictures" included "Toccatine" or "Dance of Sasun"
 - "Capriccio"
 - "Poem"
2. Any composition of S. Rachmaninov
3. One composition up to the participant's choice
